

How to make an owl plant pot



You will need:

Used and washed juice or milk carton
Colouring pencils/pens/paints
Scissors
Scrap paper/card
Glue

What to do:

1. On your carton, draw a line to cut along for the height of your pot.
2. Cut along the line carefully.
3. To make ears, draw a line across the top corner of the left and right sides of your pot.
4. Cut along the lines and fold out the ears.
5. Paint or decorate your pot.
6. Cut a diamond shape out of card for the beak and glue it on.
7. Make eyes out of paper, card or use carton lids like us.

We have made an owl but there are lots of different animals you could make. You could decorate your pot with your own drawings or with a collage of pictures cut out from magazines. You could decorate the pot with pictures of what you have planted inside. Send photos of your finished plant pot to museumeducation@stoke.gov.uk

If you are using your plant pot to grow seeds in, ask an adult to help you poke a few drainage holes into the bottom of the carton.
