

## Make a Peter Rabbit Hat



**Peter Rabbit is a much loved animal character in the children's stories by Beatrix Potter. He first appeared in The Tale of Peter Rabbit in 1902.**

### **You will need:**

Colouring pencils/pens  
Sticky tape  
Gluestick  
Cardboard - we used a frozen pizza box

### **What to do:**

1. Headband - cut a long strip from your card (it needs to fit around your head). Colour or decorate before you tape it into a circle for your headband.
2. Ears - draw part-way around a plate to make two long rabbit ear shapes. Colour and cut out.
3. Snout - draw two overlapping circles using inside your roll of tape for cheeks.
4. Draw around your gluestick for the nose. Colour and cut out.
5. Eyes - draw around your gluestick for eyes. Colour and cut out.
6. Glue or tape your rabbit ears, nose and eyes to your headband.

You can glue scrap paper or cotton wool on to your rabbit hat to make whiskers and a tail.

## How to Make a Peter Rabbit Hat.
