

How to make a scarecrow



Make a scarecrow inspired by the book, *The Scarecrow's Wedding* by Julia Donaldson. The book tells the story of two scarecrows, Betty O'Barley and Harry O'Hay and the problems they face when planning their wedding.

You will need:

Scarecrow template
Colouring pencils/pens
Gluestick
Scissors
Wool
Scrap fabric or paper for patches
Split pins

What to do:

1. Colour in your scarecrow
2. Cut out
3. Cut some small squares of fabric or paper to glue on for patches
4. Join arms and legs with split pins and glue on some fabric/paper for hands and feet
5. Thread a 40cm long strand of wool through the arms and legs
6. Pull the wool to make him dance

If you don't have split pins you can thread through a short length of wool and knot it front and back.

If your scarecrow arms and legs won't move, try loosening the pins.

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Follow the pictures from left to right to make a scarecrow.
