You will need:

Mask template
Crayons
Straw
Tape
Scissors



Have a go at making a mask inspired by Peter Rabbit. Peter Rabbit is a much loved animal character in the children's stories by Beatrix Potter. He first appeared in *The Tale of Peter Rabbit* in 1902.

What to do:

1. Print the mask template onto A4 card or paper.
2. Colour in the mask.
3. Cut out the mask. Ask an adult to help you with cutting out the eyes.
4. Tape a straw onto the back of the mask.
5. Decorate the mask with any craft materials you have at home.
